Emotions in the US election tweets

Instructions Hide

- Attempt HITs only if you are a native speaker of English, or very fluent in English.

Q1. Which of the following best describes the **emotions in this tweet (emotions of the tweeter or emotions of the people mentioned in the tweet):**

- This tweet has no emotional content.
- There is some emotion here, but the tweet does not give enough context to determine which emotion it is.
- This tweet expresses or suggests an emotional attitude or response to something.
- This tweet expresses or suggests two or more contrasting emotional attitudes or responses. (For example, the tweeter likes X but dislikes Y and Z.)
- It is not possible to decide which of the above options is appropriate because of reasons such as: the tweet does not give enough information, one needs additional context to understand the emotion, and the tweet does not make sense because of weird spellings.

EXAMPLE 1 *Tweeter: Both democrats and republicans were visibly ecstatic, and cheered Ryan's selection as VP candidate.*

We can reasonably deduce that the republicans and democrats are happy (emotion) about Ryan's selection as VP candidate. Thus the correct response is: This tweet expresses or suggests an emotional attitude or response to something.

EXAMPLE 2 *Tweeter: Save jobs with #Obama or move back to the 1800s with Liar #Romney #Corrupt*

We can reasonably deduce that the tweeter trusts (emotion) Obama because (according to the tweeter) Obama will save jobs. We can also deduce that the tweeter dislikes (emotion) Romney because (according to the tweeter) Romney is a liar and he is corrupt. Thus the correct response is: This tweet expresses or suggests two or more contrasting emotional attitudes or responses.

Q2. Which of the following best describes the **style of this tweet?**

- simple statement or question (Example: "Biden and Ryan had a testy exchange.")
- exaggeration or hyperbole (Example: "For a moment, it looked like Biden would give Ryan a noogie.")

Notes:

- A tweet may not explicitly express emotions. However, often people's emotions towards other people or entities can still be deduced. The goal here is to identify if emotions are conveyed in a tweet even if they are not explicitly stated.
